Website and Social Media Guidelines

Kentucky Emergency Management (KYEM) maintains a website and various social media sites which provide information to and receive comments from citizens. KYEM reserves the right to remove any postings which are deemed to be inappropriate.

For maximum effectiveness, it is necessary that all comments and posts follow the following guidelines.

Posts Must:

- Be original opinions of the poster
- Continue with the theme of the blog or posting; remaining on topic

Posts May Not:

- Mislead
- Infringe on copyrights or trademarks
- Promote particular services, products, or political organization
- Advocate illegal activity
- Offend, provoke, or goad others
- Contain offensive comments that target or disparage any civic organization, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, age, or religious group
- Contain personal attacks of any type or promote violence
- Contain vulgar language or be obscene, abusive, hateful, or defamatory
- Invade the personal, private rights of others
- Contain any harmful link or application
- Violate any local, state, or federal laws and/or is otherwise unlawful

Individuals participate at their own risk and are responsible for their comments, user name, and any information provided. Any external links provided on these sites do not constitute a KYEM endorsement.

Participants should have no expectation of privacy and are advised that any posts to these government agency sites are subject to the Kentucky Open Records Law.
