

Next Steps

- KYEM will work with FEMA to identify which counties should be added to declarations
- Multiple applicant briefings will be held - potential applicants must attend a briefing
- Applicants must officially apply for FEMA assistance
- Applicant must apply within 30 days of declaration date
- After briefings, FEMA will schedule individual Kickoff Meetings with each applicant
- Applicants have 60 days from Kickoff Meeting to identify all damages/projects to FEMA

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Applicants in multiple disasters **MUST** submit a Request for Public Assistance for **EACH** disaster
- Ensure the right person is selected to be the Applicant's Agent
- Applicant Agent Certification Course will be held in Frankfort the week of May 18.
 - Register at www.kyem.ky.gov
 - Only 10 openings left
