Welcome - Meeting Call to Order:

Geni Jo Brawner called the meeting to order at 1:03 pm. Ms Brawner welcomed everyone to the meeting and gave an overview of the Agenda.

The State Hazard Mitigation Plan:

Ms Brawner told the group the state plan was approved by FEMA on October 17th. Nick Grinstead gave a summary of the status of the Enhanced portion of the Plan that primarily focuses on Loss Avoidance. In addition, FEMA advised KYEM to change our concept and incorporate more CHAMPS information and make it more graphically oriented. Plan will be submitted to FEMA - ASAP pending changes and updates.

Ms Brawner requested if anyone on the Mitigation Council was interested in participating on a planning subcommittee. The subcommittee would have regular meetings moving into the future.

Project Update:

Ms Brawner gave an update on the EHP process and E-Clear packet. Clearinghouse assigns and AIP number for reference and tracking purposes and then generates an hard-copy summary that FEMA utilizes in their review to facilitate the process. Nancy Price asked status of Morgan County projects, Ryan Hubbs will follow up on the status of DR4057 Morgan County projects. Each Grants Specialists gave summary of their projects. Please find attached the PowerPoint presentation.

Esther White and Brian Gathy updated on Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) and Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) submitted 22 applications that FEMA closed on October 18th. See power point slides. Awarded projects will be forthcoming. Ms White sent out an email to 36 jurisdictions about the availability of the online programs and recieved 15 responses. 13 of the Applications were worth \$14.1 million and 3 PDMs worth \$1.7 million. Edgewood Soil stabilization project was highlighted- 2 properties that have had \$60K in damages since 2008.

Governor's Emergency Management Workshop (GEMW):

Nancy Price updated the KYMC regarding GEMW is December 9-10 in Frankfort. See slides. Location site will be announced and all notified later this week.

CHAMPS Update:

Doug Eades gave an update on CHAMPS, and showed the information video.
