Course Description:

Interviewing witnesses, Search Area Considerations, Recovery videos, Wet & Dry drowning, Elapsed time from drowning considerations, Effects of drowning with various types of current, setting up a recovery operation, where do you start your recovery operation? Search techniques & resources, Technology at its best: Side scan, Underwater camera and ROV video's, Search and Recovery Operations, Decision making, Operations Risk / Benefit Factor, Demonstrating Search Patterns, Vehicle evidence collections warrants, Search and recovery warrants for diving and Equipment usage and Recommended Dive Equipment. Class begins at 9:00 a.m. and closes at 5:00 p.m.

Student Criteria:

This 16 hour course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or other organization having responsibility for water based recovery operation. **You MUST be at least 18 years old to register for this class.**
