Course Description:

ICS 100, Introduction to the Incident Command System, introduces the Incident Command System (ICS) and provides the foundation for higher level ICS training. This course describes the history, features and principles, and organizational structure of the Incident Command System. It also explains the relationship between ICS and the National Incident Management System (NIMS).

Student Criteria:

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or other organization having responsibility for incident management. There are no prerequisites for this course.

Special Notes:

A MINIMUM # of twenty (20) advance student registrations is REQUIRED and must be received by Wednesday., August 1, 2012 in order to conduct this course. You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application so you will not receive a letter acknowledging that acceptance.
