Course Description:

Emergency Response Planning for EHS Facilities is a course designed to provide active Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) members, specifically planners, with an understanding of the federal and state requirements for Extremely Hazardous Substance (EHS) Facility Emergency Response Plans. After completing this course, LEPC members should be able to describe the legal planning responsibilities contained in the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA), Kentucky Revised Statutes (KRS) and Kentucky Administrative Statutes (KAR), describe the sections and content of EHS Facility Plans in Kentucky, identify the LEPC deadlines for planning paperwork submission, and identify Kentucky Emergency Response Commission (KERC) required and optional forms.

Student Criteria:

Recommended prerequisite for this course is completion of the LEPCs in Kentucky course.
