This course introduces and overviews the National Incident Management System (NIMS). NIMS provides a consistent nationwide template to enable all government, private-sector, and non-governmental organizations to work together during domestic incidents.

**Student Criteria:**

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or other organization having responsibility for incident management. Prerequisites for this course include ICS 700, 800 and ICS 100 for this course. Please upload all course certificates with the registration form prior to the class.

**Special Notes:**

A MINIMUM # of twenty (20) advance student registrations is REQUIRED and must be received by July 12, 2012 in order to conduct this course. You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application so you will not receive a letter acknowledging that acceptance.
