Course Description:

This is a four (4) hour course required for all local emergency management directors, paid and volunteer. Session will prepare participants to lead and/or conduct disaster damage assessments as part of a local government damage assessment. Course includes reference to the Kentucky Operations Plan. **The class will begin at 9:00am and conclude at approximately 1:00 pm.**

Student Criteria:

No prerequisites. Students should have an existing or potential assignment as part of the local government damage assessment or disaster recovery plan.

Special Notes:

Advance student registration is REQUIRED and must be received by **May 1, 2011** in order to participate in this course. **MAXIMUM # of student seats available is thirty (30)**.
