Course Description:

The Jurisdictional Threat Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA) course prepares participants to conduct a jurisdictional THIRA. Participant activities focus on the jurisdictional process for determining the ability to respond to human-caused, natural, and technological disasters. Participants will identify threats and hazards of concern, give the threats and hazards context, examine the core capabilities, set capability targets, and apply the results. **Course starts at 8:00 a.m. and concludes at 5 p.m. each day.**

Student Criteria:

This course is open to Emergency Management, Elected Officials, Emergency Medical Services, Fire Service, Healthcare, Hazardous Materials, Law Enforcement, Public Health, Public Safety Communications, Public Works and other community representatives involved with emergency planning and preparedness. Prerequisite is the online courses IS-700.a: National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction. AWR-160-W: WMD/Terrorism Awareness for Emergency Responders is recommended, but not required. (Please make sure that your IS-700 is emailed to the POC listed below prior to attending the class)

Special Notes:

Advance student registration is **REQUIRED** and must be received by February 15th, 2017 in order to participate in this course. This course minimum is 15 students. You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application by this office so you will not receive a letter acknowledging that acceptance. Meals, lodging, and travel arrangements/expenses are the responsibility of the student and will **NOT** be reimbursed by KYEM unless otherwise noted.
