To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come:

WHEREAS, Severe weather can strike at any time in Kentucky, causing extensive and long-lasting effects upon Kentuckians; and

WHEREAS, Severe weather impacts personal lives, social structure and the economy on both local and state levels; and

WHEREAS, The Kentucky Division of Emergency Management is responsible for preparing Kentucky for all forms of natural disasters, including severe storms; and

WHEREAS, It is appropriate that the Kentucky Division of Emergency Management should cooperate with other state and federal government agencies, the National Weather Service, Kentucky Weather Preparedness Committee, local emergency officials and private corporations to prepare the citizens of the Commonwealth;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANDY BESHEAR, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, do hereby proclaim March 1-7, 2020, as

SEVERE WEATHER AWARENESS WEEK

in Kentucky, and urge all Kentuckians to note its observance and prepare for the threat of severe weather.
