Both as a way to display Kentucky's effective use of available mitigation funding and its firm commitment to a comprehensive mitigation program, this appendix shows the results of internal administrative policy implemented by Kentucky Emergency Management (KYEM) starting in 2011 (i.e. with presidential-disaster declaration 1976): All Public Assistance (PA) projects being assessed must also be assessed for eligibility as a "Section 406" mitigation project. By taking into consideration whether or not Public Assistance (PA) projects also provided eligibility for mitigation projects, the Commonwealth of Kentucky from 2011 – 2012 was able to apply for and effectively use a further \$420,283.62 for mitigation activity associated with 272 Public Assistance Program project.
