FEMA released a Fact Sheet on Alternate Care Site (ACS) “Warm Sites” addressing the authority to provide funding for costs associated with keeping Alternate Care Sites (ACS), including temporary and expanded medical facilities, minimally operational when coronavirus (COVID-19) cases diminish and the facilities are no longer in use.

The [FEMA Fact Sheet](#) states that State, local, tribal, and territorial (SLTT) governments may, under certain conditions, be reimbursed through FEMA Public Assistance (PA) Program for costs associated with keeping ACS, including temporary and expanded medical facilities, minimally operational when COVID-19 cases diminish and the facilities are no longer in use.
