# HazMat IQ Tactics - Propane Emergencies Campbellsville Fire- Rescue

### Course Description:

HazMat Propane IQ is a 16-hour course that will prepare responders to safely mitigate propane emergencies, including tactical considerations, container assessment, leak control options, and flaring operations. Each student will receive a set of PropaneIQ Smart Charts with a diagram of each propane vessel, along with potential countermeasures for each leak.

### Student Criteria:

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Environmental, HazMat Response, Emergency Medical, Law Enforcement personnel or any organization having responsibility for responding to a hazardous materials incident. HazMat Awareness and Operations class would be beneficial to the student.

### Special Notes:

Students will need helmets, eye protection, work/rescue gloves, and firefighter turn out gear or Nomex outwear (such as brush or extrication gear). SCBAs are not needed. Students without PPE may observe the practical sessions, but not participate.

Advance student registration is REQUIRED and must be received by **March 23, 2020** in order to participate in this course. MAXIMUM number of student seats available is 24. You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application by this office so you will not receive a letter acknowledging that acceptance. Meals, lodging, and travel arrangements/expenses are the responsibility of the student and will NOT be reimbursed by KYEM unless otherwise noted.
