Course Description

This seminar will be held on three different dates (all listed above) to give more opportunities for participation, **it is only necessary to participate in one to receive credit**. A Distribution Management Plan establishes strategies, functional plans, and tactical guidance for State and local logistical response operations. The plan covers staging sites, operations, and logistical support including services, personnel, transportation of resources to the point of need, commodity points of distribution (C-PODs), inventory management, resource sourcing, fuel management, and demobilization. The plan should address all components of distribution management from defining requirements to demobilization and inventorying resources from small incidents to catastrophic events. Each participant will have the opportunity to complete deliverables during class in the survey tool.

Student Criteria

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or other organizations having responsibility for incident management, disaster response, or planning. No pre-requisites required to attend.

Special Notes

This class will count as one of the required EMPG exercises for this year with completion of the EMA 22 contract requirements. A maximum of sixty (60) participants will be accepted. You are considered accepted as a participant in this workshop upon receipt of your application. Letters of acceptance will not be sent. Meals, lodging, and travel expenses are the responsibility of the student and will *NOT* be reimbursed by KYEM.
