Course Description

This advanced-level course equips emergency management professionals with the skills and knowledge to serve as Finance/Administration Unit Leaders (FAULs) within an Incident Command System (ICS). Participants will explore the full scope of financial operations in an all-hazards environment, including: *Unit Setup & Management*, establishing and organizing the Finance/Admin Unit within the ICS structure; *Time Unit Operations*, tracking personnel time and ensuring documentation; *Procurement Procedures*, managing contracts, purchases, and vendor coordination; *Compensation & Claims*, handling injury claims, property damage, and liability issues; *Cost Analysis*, monitoring and reporting incident-related costs for budgeting and reimbursement; *Information Gathering & Reporting*, collecting financial data and producing timely reports for incident leadership; *Inter-unit Coordination*, collaborating with other ICS units to ensure seamless financial operations. *Class will begin at 8:00 a.m. EST until 5:00 p.m. EST each day*.

Student Criteria

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or other organization having responsibility for incident management. **Pre-requisites include** *IS100, IS200, ICS300, IS700, and IS800*. Copies of these course completion certificates must be provided before the class to the POC listed below.

Special Notes

A MINIMUM of fifteen (15) advance student registrations is REQUIRED and must be received by August 10, 2025. A MAXIMUM of twenty-five (25) will be accepted. You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application. Letters of acceptance will not be sent. Meals, lodging, and travel expenses are the responsibility of the student and will *NOT* be reimbursed by KYEM.
