# **HazMat Advanced Awareness Permit Required Confined Space Entry 4-Hour Virtual Training Thursday, December 02, 2021 12:00pm – 4:00pm (EST)**

### **Course Description:**

Designed for first responders to gain general knowledge of OSHA's Permit-Required Confined Space. This 4-hour course covers the federal requirements, how to protect confined space rescuers, atmospheric testing, ventilation, proper respirator and PPE use, attendants, and basic rescue procedures. Applicable Standards OSHA 29 CFR 1910.146, OSHA 29 CFR 1910.147

### **Learning Objectives/Topics Covered:**

- The characteristics of a confined space and what makes it a permit-required confined space
- Identify hazards associated with entry and rescue per OSHA 1910.146
- The three main atmospheric hazards and other health and safety dangers
- Identify the equipment and PPE that may be required for confined space entry
- Understanding safety requirements of isolation and ventilation
- Have a working knowledge of components of a confined space program

### **Student Criteria:**

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Environmental, HazMat Response, Emergency Medical, Law Enforcement personnel or any organization having responsibility for responding to a hazardous materials incident. Students are evaluated on their attentiveness during instruction and participation in small group activities and class discussions.

**Prerequisites: We strongly recommend students complete an 8 hour HazMat Awareness Course.**

### **Special Notes:**

Advance student registration is REQUIRED and must be received by **November 25, 2021** in order to participate in this course. MAXIMUM number of participants is 24 students per session. *You will receive an email with your Virtual Training Log In information.* This course is geared towards certification.
