Course Description

The Jurisdictional Threat Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA) course prepares participants to conduct a jurisdictional THIRA. Participant activities focus on the jurisdictional process for determining the ability to respond to human-caused, natural, and technological disasters. Participants will identify threats and hazards of concern, give the threats and hazards context, examine the core capabilities, set capability targets, and apply the results.

Student Criteria

This course is open to Emergency Management, Elected Officials, Emergency Medical Services, Fire Service, Healthcare, Hazardous Materials, Law Enforcement, Other, Public Health, Public Safety Communications, Public Works. **Prerequisite is the online courses IS-700.a: National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction and must be emailed to the POC listed below.** AWR-160-W: WMD/Terrorism Awareness for Emergency Responders is recommended, but not required.

Special Notes

Advance student registration is REQUIRED and must be received by **November 20, 2018** in order to participate in this course. This course minimum is 15 students. You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application by this office so you will not receive a letter acknowledging that acceptance.
