Course Description

The target audience for this course is all levels of government and whole community partners. This course assists continuity practitioners with understanding their continuity roles and responsibilities, and provides them with the knowledge, skills and tools necessary to help develop and maintain a viable continuity plan for their organization. The course materials are based on guidance found in Federal Continuity Directives (FCDs) 1 and 2 and the Continuity Guidance Circular (CGC) for developing continuity plans and programs. By the end of the course students will possess the ability to build a draft continuity plan and understand the key roles necessary for developing critical mitigation strategies and key elements of a continuity capability. **Class will begin promptly at 8:00 am EST and will finish at 5:00 pm EST.**

Student Criteria

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or other organization having responsibility for incident management. The prerequisite for this course is the self-study course IS-1300. This must be completed and certificate submitted prior to the class date. **Students will be emailed a package near the class date that will include an application that MUST be filled out and submitted to EMI BEFORE class begins.** The student materials for the class will be digital. The link to the student handbook will be sent with the EMI packet.

Special Notes

A minimum of twenty (20) student registrations is REQUIRED and must be received by January 15, 2025. A MAXIMUM of thirty (30) will be accepted. You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application. Letters of acceptance will not be sent. Meals, lodging and travel expenses are the responsibility of the student and will not be reimbursed by KYEM.
