Course Description

This course teaches how to create effective training plans using a whole community approach. You will learn a jurisdiction training assessment process in which an integrated assessment team creates a jurisdictional profile and evaluates the ability to fully implement the Emergency Operations Plans (EOP). You will then be able to identify and catalog training gaps and identify ways to close them by prioritizing training efforts, developing improvement plans, and implementing a course of action. Course will be from 8:00am-4:30pm EST each day.

Student Criteria

This course is open to Emergency Management, Elected Officials, Emergency Medical Services, Fire Service, Healthcare, Hazardous Materials, Law Enforcement, School Officials, Private Sector, Religious Organizations, Public Health, Public Safety Communications, Public Works and Volunteer Organizations.
