First Engine In – On Scene For Emergency Responders 2-Hour Virtual Training Thursday, January 20, 2022 12:00am – 2:00pm (EST)

Course Description:

This two hour First-in Engine course utilizes the RINSED mnemonic (first proposed by Fridley Fire Department) to assist in the organization of a hazardous materials scene by the first-in engine crew. The objectives of Recognize, Identify, Notify, Scene security, Evacuation and Decontamination (RINSED) are reviewed. The class is divided into teams and each team is provided with a hazardous materials spill scenario and the First-in Responder Incident Action Plan Worksheet to complete and present to the class. The class is compliant with 29CFR 1910.120(q)(6)(i) First responder awareness level and the competencies described in 29CFR 1910.120(q)(6)(i)(A-F) of the OSHA Hazardous waste operations and emergency response (HAZWOPER) standard. The class is also compliant with NFPA 472 (Ed. 2018) Chapter 4, Competencies for Awareness Level Personnel.

Student Criteria:

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Environmental, HazMat Response, Emergency Medical, Law Enforcement personnel or any organization having responsibility for responding to a hazardous materials incident. Students are evaluated on their attentiveness during instruction and participation in small group activities and class discussions. Facilitators may request cameras on and/or participation via chat messaging. **Prerequisites: 8-Hour HazMat Operation Course is encouraged.**

Special Notes:

Advance student registration is REQUIRED and must be received by **January 13, 2022** in order to participate in this course. MAXIMUM number of participants is 24 students per session. Meals, lodging, and travel arrangements/expenses are the responsibility of the student and will NOT be reimbursed by KYEM unless otherwise noted. *You will receive an email with your Virtual Training Log In information.*
