Course Description

These are some of the benefits of an effective Rapid Needs Assessment. A good assessment will allow community leaders to prioritize response actions to have the greatest life-saving and life sustaining benefits. As resources will be limited on the local level during the first few hours of a disaster or emergency event, the Rapid Needs Assessment should allow for the effective use of resources. Likewise, it will allow local officials to request those resources that are not available locally and are needed to support life sustaining and life saving measures. **Class will start at 10:00 AM CST.**

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or other organization having responsibility for incident management.
