**COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

In this course participants will enhance their skills to formulate considerations for the resiliency of jurisdictional assets leveraging cross-sector partnerships. These considerations will enhance the whole community's ability to manage the risk associated with CI protection efforts. The course will implement the National Preparedness Goal by facilitating the development of Resiliency Action Plans, involving all jurisdictional CI partners. Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to increase infrastructure owner-operator participation in jurisdictional planning, organizing, equipping, training, and exercising CI protection efforts.

Individuals completing this course in combination with MGT310, MGT315, and AWR213, are awarded the TEEX Infrastructure Protection Certificate.

Public and private sector Critical Infrastructure owners, operators, and managers; State, local, and territorial government senior officials and managers; Homeland Security personnel; Sector-Specific Agency managers; and Other managers with critical infrastructure responsibilities
