### Debris Training

June 2-6, 2025

#### Course Description

The 6-hour course will provide instruction for conducting debris operations that are efficient, effective, and eligible for FEMA PA grant funding. By the end of the course, students will be able to ensure that all work performed is in accordance with PA guidelines and all applicable Federal and SLTT laws and regulations. **Class will start promptly at 9:00 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m. each day.**

#### Student Criteria

The debris course is intended for Public Assistance Applicants (cities, counties, KYTC) that participate in the Public Assistance (PA) Program and may have debris removal operations after an event. The course materials were developed with the assumption that audience members may have little or no actual experience managing debris operations. **NO prerequisite.**

You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon registration. Letters of acceptance will not be sent. Meals, lodging, and travel expenses are the responsibility of the student and will *NOT* be reimbursed by KYEM.
