This comprehensive training is designed to equip local and state-level emergency responders with the essential skills and knowledge required to effectively serve as an Incident Commander (IC) on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). This course will enhance the students understanding of the duties and responsibilities of an IC. It will help mastering the skills needed for an effective incident command by applying knowledge through realistic, scenario-driven exercises. The duration of the course is five days. The course will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. EST each morning.

Student Criteria

This course is ideal for emergency responders who are regularly assigned to Functional, Support, or Unit Leader positions on Type 3 or 4 AHIMTs, or those seeking credentials/certification in these roles. *Prerequisites: ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300, ICS-400, IS-700, IS-800. Please send prerequisite certificates as one PDF to the POC below prior to the start of the class.* You must be 18 years old to register for this class. By completing this course, you will gain a robust understanding of the capabilities and responsibilities of an effective IC, preparing you to respond to a wide range of incidents, from fires to mass-casualty events.

Special Notes

Advance student registration is required on the KYEM website. Prior to the class you will be sent a link so that you can also register on the NETC website with a SID number. All the information about this will be emailed to you at a later date. A **MINIMUM of twenty (20)** advance student registrations is **REQUIRED**. Registration must be received by May 20, 2025. A **MAXIMUM of thirty (30)** students will be accepted. You are considered accepted as a student in the class upon receipt of your application. Letter of acceptance will not be sent. Meals, lodging, and travel expenses are the responsibility of the student and will NOT be reimbursed by KYEM. *The materials for this course will be delivered in digital format. A copy of the student manual will be sent to you prior to the start of the class.*
