**Lost Person Behavior [Train the Trainer]

Course Description:

The Lost Person Behavior Course has been taught to SAR professionals around the world and is currently used by the governments around the world for standard instruction. Participants will attend the full Lost Person Behavior Program, as well as receive in-depth instruction that goes above and beyond the actual course. Participants will walk away with new practical knowledge, a license to instruct the course, and a wealth of material, including Lost Person Behavior Instructor's Resource USB, *Lost Person Behavior Workbook*, *Instructor Notes*, *Practical Guide*, *Search Wheel*, and *EVAC*. *The LPB TTT class will require the full three-days. Class will get underway at 8:00 a.m. EST and will end at 5:00 p.m. EST except for the last day and it will end at 3:00 p.m. EST*

Student Criteria:

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or any organization having responsibility for searching for missing or lost persons. The ideal student will have both search and search management experience. The class will not devote much time to instructional techniques, thus the participant should feel comfortable instructing. *The Basic Search and Rescue Course (BSAR) is a prerequisite for this class.*

Special Notes:

The number of students in this class will be capped at twenty-four (24) advance student registrations, and must be received by **June 20, 2025** in order to participate in this course. You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application by this office so you will not receive a letter acknowledging that acceptance. Meals, lodging, and travel arrangements/expenses are the responsibility of the student and will NOT be reimbursed by KYEM.
