COURSE TITLE: **Flooding Hazards: Science and Preparedness (AWR-362)**

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Flooding hazards can threaten any community in any location in the United States. Flooding can occur over a period of weeks or days, or minutes, thus this course focuses the identification and assessment of hazards due to flooding to enable proper preparedness and response. As flooding is one of the top meteorological killers in the United States, and poses particular hazards to emergency responders, this introduction to recognizing flooding threats is essential for developing safe communities.

Flooding Hazards: Science and Preparedness is an awareness-level, eight hour course that addresses the current science of the causes of floods (both meteorological and otherwise), flood forecasting, flood risk assessment, and best practices for preparation and mitigation for both short and long-fuse flooding events.

Emergency Management, Emergency Medical Services, Fire Service, Government Administrative, Public Health, Law Enforcement and Public Works
