### Course Description

The Jurisdictional Threat Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA) course prepares participants to conduct a jurisdictional THIRA. Participant activities focus on the jurisdictional process for determining the ability to respond to human-caused, natural, and technological disasters. Participants will identify threats and hazards of concern, give the threats and hazards context, examine the core capabilities, set capability targets, and apply the results. Class will begin at 9:00am EDT and ending at 5:00pm EDT each day.

### Student Criteria

This course is open to Emergency Management, Elected Officials, Emergency Medical Services, Fire Service, Healthcare, Hazardous Materials, Law Enforcement, Other, Public Health, Public Safety Communications, Public Works. **Prerequisite is the online courses IS-700.a: National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction** and AWR-160-W: WMD/Terrorism Awareness for Emergency Responders is recommended, but not required. **Please make sure that your IS-700 is emailed to the POC listed below prior to attending the class.**

### Special Notes

Advance student registration is REQUIRED and must be received by **February 13, 2019** in order to participate in this course. **This course minimum is 25 students and a maximum of 40.** You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application by this office so you will not receive a letter acknowledging that acceptance. Meals, lodging, and travel expenses are the responsibility of the student and will *NOT* be reimbursed by KYEM unless otherwise noted.
