**SEARCH MANAGEMENT FOR THE
INITIAL RESPONSE INCIDENT COMMANDER (ERI – SEARCH MANAGEMENT)

Course Description:

This twenty (20) hour course meets the minimum search management training requirement specified in 106 KAR 1:390 for local search and rescue coordinators. The class is designed for individuals responsible for investigating reports of lost or overdue individuals, and for initiating appropriate search responses. It is designed to provide a systematic and logical method whereby incident commanders and managers are able to make rapid decisions on tactics and the application of resources. Class will begin at 8:00am Central Time and end at 6:00pm Central Time on both Saturday and Sunday.

Student Criteria:

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or any organization having responsibility for searching for missing or lost persons. The prerequisites for this course are completion of the twenty (20) hour Basic Search and Rescue Course (BSAR) course offered by the Kentucky Division of Emergency Management (KYEM), and IS-100 and IS-200. Copies of the course completion certificates must be emailed to the POC below, before the beginning of class.

Special Notes:

A MINIMUM # fifteen (15) advance student registrations is REQUIRED and must be received by Mar 3rd, 2020 in order to conduct this course. Maximum registrations are 25 students. You are considered registered for this course once this office receives your on-line application. Letters acknowledging registration will not be sent. Meals, lodging, and travel arrangements/expenses are the responsibility of the student and will *NOT* be reimbursed by KYEM.
