Haz-Mat Technician Refresher

Course Description:

The 8-hour course provides HAZMAT Team members with the basic knowledge and skills to take appropriate offensive or defensive action that would require level A & B protection at an incident.

Topics of instruction include: identification & classification of materials, selection of PPE, hazard & risk assessment techniques and advanced control & containment operations. Students will also acquire an understanding of basic chemical and toxicological behavior as well as how to function within the Incident Command System. Instruction will include classroom and hands on exercises.

Student Criteria:

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or any organization having responsibility for mitigation of a hazardous materials incident. Familiarity with SCBA is necessary. Face shall be clean shaven in areas encountered by face mask seal. Students must also not have any medical problems, which would preclude them from participating in hands on exercises and **MUST** be at least 18 years old to register for this class. **Pre-requisites: per 29 CFR 1910.120, students must have completed a "Hazardous Materials Technician" course within the preceding twelve months or have received prior training as a Hazardous Material Technician and completion of a refresher course within the last twelve months. A copy of course completion certificate(s) mentioned above must be emailed to the POC below, before the beginning of class.**

Special Notes:

Advance student registration is **REQUIRED** and must be received by **March 10, 2020** in order to participate in this course. Maximum number of student seats available is twenty-four (24). Meals, lodging, and travel arrangements/expenses are the responsibility of the student and will **NOT** be reimbursed by KYEM unless otherwise noted.
