Course Description: This half-day spokesperson training is for public information officers, public affairs officers, policymakers, elected officials, government officials, and subject-matterexperts who are likely to interact with the news media before, during, or after an emergency event. Participants will engage in a variety of intense and fast-paced news interviews, including one-on-one, on-camera, and remote on-camera interviews. Message mapping development, interview preparation, remote staging methodology, and news conference stagecraft will be emphasized and reinforced throughout this workshop. This is a highly-interactive class for beginners and pros alike, conducted in a positive, supportive atmosphere.

Student Criteria: This course is open to federal, state, and local communication related personnel. There are no prerequisites for this course. **CSEPP community registrants receive registration priority.**

Special Notes: A MINIMUM # of four (4) advance student registrations is **REQUIRED** and must be received by May 13, 2024. A **MAXIMUM # of Twelve (12)** will be accepted. You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application. Letters of acceptance will not be sent. Students will be notified if the course is canceled.
