This eight-hour awareness-level course for school administrators and emergency responders will educate rural law enforcement personnel as well as school administrators and staff to effectively respond to an emergency involving a school building or an entire school system. The training will provide representatives of rural law enforcement departments with a foundation of knowledge and skills that will enable them to progressively establish a school-based emergency response plan and crisis management team through information sharing and training. **Class will begin at 8:00am EST and end at 5:00pm EST.**

A minimum of 20 and a maximum of 40 advanced student registrations are required and must be received by 03/31/2020 in order to conduct this course. You are considered registered for this course once this office receives your online application. Letters of acceptance will not be sent.
