Course Description

This 40 hour curriculum is designed to meet all the requirements for a “Basic and Intermediate Rope Course” as set forth in Kentucky Administrative Regulation 106 KAR 1:390 under the Statutory Authority of Kentucky Revised Statute 39F.210. To receive a Certificate of Completion from the Kentucky Division of Emergency Management, students must be checked off on all the Intermediate skills and knowledge items listed on the KYEM Form “Technical Rope Rescue Technician Level Training Record” issued in 2013. The curriculum is also designed to meet all the requirements, other than the final AHJ Evaluator sign-off, of the NFPA 1006 - “Standard for Technical Rescuer Professional Qualifications - Technical Rope Rescuer level 1.

Class will begin 7:00 p.m. EDT Friday night May 31st, and 8:00 a.m. EDT and end at 5:00p.m. EDT on Saturdays and Sundays.

Student Criteria

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or any organization having responsibility for searching for missing or lost persons. Participants must be prepared to pass a fitness test of (1) push-up, (1) sit-up, (1) pull-up and (1) mile walk in 20 minutes.

Special Notes

A **MINIMUM** # eight (8) advance student registrations is **REQUIRED** and must be received by **May 10, 2019** in order to conduct this course. **Maximum registrations are 12 students.** You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of an email acknowledging the acceptance of your registration request. Meals, lodging, and travel expenses are the responsibility of the student and will **NOT** be reimbursed by KYEM.
