Course Description

The G-191 Interface Workshop enables participants to develop an effective interface between the Incident Command and the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) for their community by applying Incident Command System (ICS) principles. The course works best when delivered to Incident Command System and Emergency Operations Center personnel from the same community. The course reviews ICS and EOC responsibilities and functions, depending heavily on exercises and group discussions to formulate the interface.

Student Criteria

Recommended prerequisites: IS-100 and IS-200. This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency, Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel, or any organization having community or EOC/ICS responsibility.

Special Notes

Advance student registration is **REQUIRED** and must be received by **October 18, 2018**. You are considered accepted as a student in this class upon receipt of your application by this office so you will not receive a letter acknowledging that acceptance.
