Course Description

The course is designed to strengthen the abilities of local jurisdictions to successfully prepare for and handle volunteer and donations management issues that may arise during an incident. More specifically, the course content and activities serve as a template for enhancing response to such pitfalls as donation of unsolicited goods, unaffiliated volunteers, and undesignated cash. This training also provides information regarding the state's volunteer and donations management responsibilities, which are designed to help build relationships between government and nongovernmental organizations. Class will begin at 9:00 am and will end at 5:00 pm CST on the first day. Class will begin at 9:00 am and end at 1:00 pm CST on the second day.

Student Criteria

The intended audiences are federal, state, tribal, territorial, local level, business and non-governmental emergency management personnel. The course is particularly beneficial to those who may be designed to develop an effective public education and information structure to support the successful management of unaffiliated volunteers, unsolicited goods, and undesignated cash donations in disasters.
