Course Description:

Lost person behavior is the cornerstone of search and rescue efforts. Based upon a landmark study, this class is the definitive guide to solving the puzzle of where a lost person might be found. Nowhere else is it possible to learn about the latest subject categories, behavioral profiles, up to date statistics, suggested initial tasks, and specialized investigative questions. Whether the subject is underground, underwater, under collapsed rubble, on land or has fallen from the sky, this course delivers what search managers need. Class will begin each day at 8:00a.m. Eastern and end at 5:00 p.m. Eastern.

Student Criteria:

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, and Law Enforcement personnel or any organization having responsibility for searching for missing or lost persons. The recommended prerequisite for this course is completion of the twenty (20) hour Basic Search and Rescue Course (BSAR), offered by the Kentucky Division of Emergency Management (KYEM). A copy of the course completion should be mailed or emailed to the POC below as soon as course completion is done.

Special Notes/COVID-19 Instructions:

A MINIMUM # ten (10) advance student registrations is REQUIRED and must be received by September 25, 2020 in order to conduct this course. Maximum registrations are 30 students. **Students will be required to wear a cloth facemask and will maintain proper social distancing as per CDC and State Guidelines. No student will be allowed to attend class if they have signs or symptoms of COVID-19 or flu-like symptoms per CDC and State guidelines.** You are considered registered for this course once this office receives your electronic registration. Letters acknowledging registration will not be sent. Meals, lodging, and travel arrangements/expenses are the responsibility of the student and will *NOT* be reimbursed by KYEM unless otherwise noted.
