Course Description

WebEOC Introduction/EOC Operations. This course is designed to provide Emergency Management Professionals with a basic understanding of how to share, gather, and manage information in WebEOC. The course covers, but is not limited to, how to add/monitor:

1. Declaration Process
2. Resource Request
3. Activity Reporting
4. Significant Event Reporting
5. Infrastructure Reporting
6. Damage Assessment
7. Sheltering

Course will also discuss WebEOC, mobile applications used to feed WebEOC, and upcoming changes.

Student Criteria

This course is open to all Emergency Management personnel or any persons who have access to WebEOC and responsible for entering data.
