Course Description

The course is designed to strengthen the abilities of local jurisdictions to successfully prepare for and handle volunteer and donations management issues that may arise during an incident. The course content and activities may also serve as a template for enhancing uniformity in addressing areas of donated unsolicited goods, unaffiliated volunteers, and undesignated cash. This training also provides information regarding the state's volunteer and donations management responsibilities, which are designed to help build relationships between government and non-governmental organizations. **Class will begin at 9:00 am and will end at 5:00 pm EST each day.**

Student Criteria

The intended audiences are federal, state, tribal, territorial, local level, business and non-governmental emergency management personnel who may be designed to develop an effective public education and information structure to support the successful management of unaffiliated volunteers, unsolicited goods, and undesignated cash donations in disasters. ***The prerequisites are: IS-100 and IS-700. Both are self-taught online courses.***
