Course Description

This course provides local and state level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Operations Section Chief (OSC) on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). These responsibilities fall into two categories: 1) Responding to the incident and the command needs of the incident and 2) Effectively fulfilling the position responsibilities of an OSC on an AHIMT. This course is an instructor-led training that supports learning through discussion, lecture, and active participation in multiple exercises that provides a realistic, scenario-driven approach to mastering the skills required of an OSC. Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable participants to process and apply their new knowledge. **Class will start at 8:00 AM EST and end at 5:00 PM EST each day.**

Student Criteria

This course is open to all Emergency Management, Rescue, Fire, Emergency Medical, Law Enforcement, Telecommunicators personnel, or other organization having responsibility for incident management. NIMS-ICS All-Hazards training should be completed by personnel who are regularly assigned to Functional, Support or Unit Leader positions on Type 3 or Type 4 AHIMTs, or by those persons who desire to seek credentials/certification in those positions. The following pre-requisites are required for the course IS100, IS200, E/L/G 300, E/L/G 400, IS 700, and IS 800. **CSEPP Students have Priority Registration.**

Special Notes

A **MINIMUM # of twenty (20)** advance student registrations is **REQUIRED**. A **MAXIMUM thirty (30)** will be accepted. Upon registration with KYEM, students will receive a registration code to complete an Emergency Management Institute application for the course. Meals, lodging, and travel expenses are the responsibility of the student and will *NOT* be reimbursed by KYEM.
