Hazard Mitigation Funds Availability

404 Mitigation is available for state and local governments, and certain non-profit organizations throughout the Commonwealth.

DR4216 – Estimated Hazard Mitigation Funds - \$696,565

DR4217 – Estimated Hazard Mitigation Funds - \$3,405,540

DR4218 – Estimated Hazard Mitigation Funds - \$3,352,383

- Communities in effected areas receive priority
- Kentucky Mitigation Council sets priorities and selects proposed projects to proceed to the application process
