If your county, cities, schools, hospitals, water districts, etc. had damages to roads, bridges, culverts, buildings, equipment -

If there were emergency protective measures or debris removal costs -

REPORT ASAP

Reporting July Severe Storms Damages

- Complete and Submit
 - **Public Assistance**
 - **501 Damage Assessment Forms**
 - Public Assistance Roads, Bridges, Structures, Equipment
 - Photograph Damages and Debris
 - Capture All Costs
- Complete and Submit

Individual Damage Assessment of Homes, Residences, Businesses 551 Damage Assessment Form

- Accurately describe depth of water
- Determine or estimate insurance coverage
- Ensure addresses/names are accurate

Potential for Costs Associated With:

Widespread Flooding

- Equipment Damages
- Search, Rescue, Evacuations
- Sheltering, Food, Water
- Road, Bridges, Drainage Systems
- Establishing Detours and Barricading of Roadways
- Debris

Wind Damage

- Buildings
- Equipment
- Debris

Use of Your Own Resources

- Ensure personnel are tracking all preparation, response, and recovery time
- Track all equipment usage
- Track all materials used

Photograph areas before debris removal or damage repairs

- EOC Activations
 - Time
 - Meals
 - Staff
- Volunteer Resources Who did what, where, with what donated equipment or materials??
 - Manpower
 - Equipment
 - Materials
