Displaced tornado survivors urged to register for Commonwealth Sheltering Program

FRANKFORT, KY – Kentucky Emergency Management is still in the process of placing eligible survivors of the December 10-11 tornados whose homes were majorly damaged or destroyed into travel trailers through the Commonwealth Sheltering Program. Survivors in the following 16 counties may register for the program at governor.ky.gov/tornadoresources: Graves, Hopkins, Muhlenberg, Warren, Marshall, Caldwell, Barren, Christian, Fulton, Hart, Hickman, Logan, Lyon, Marion, Ohio, and Taylor.

Sheltering through the Commonwealth Sheltering Program is renewable on a 30-day basis. Travel trailers can be placed on a homeowner's property or on commercial property if the survivor was not a homeowner. Survivors must be seeking long-term housing solutions while participating in the Commonwealth Sheltering Program.
