SUBJECT: Issuance of FEMA Policy FP 104-010-04, *Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic: Medical Care Costs Eligible for Public Assistance*

The purpose of this memorandum is to issue the attached FEMA Policy FP 104-010-04 *Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic: Medical Care Costs Eligible for Public Assistance*. On March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared a nationwide emergency for the COVID-19 pandemic. FEMA is releasing this policy to provide clear guidance on eligible work and costs under the FEMA Public Assistance Program related to medical care needs in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.

This policy defines the framework, policy details, and requirements for determining the eligibility of medical care costs to ensure consistent and appropriate implementation across all COVID-19 emergency and major disaster declarations. Except where specifically stated otherwise in this policy, assistance is subject to PA Program requirements as defined in Version 3.1 of the *Public Assistance Program and Policy Guide*.
